

ATHLETES' VILLAGE

7.1 ACCOMMODATION

The Athletes' Village will open on 13 June 2024, two days prior to the Opening Ceremony, and close on 26 June 2024, two days after the Closing Ceremony. Accommodations for all athletes and team officials will be located in the classrooms at the Marshall Islands High School. Rooms will be assigned to delegations based upon numbers and gender.

7.2 DAMAGE POLICY

Majol2024 OC has an obligation to return the school facilities in the best possible conditions to the owners. With this in mind, it is important that the Majol2024 OC recovers any costs for restoration of any damaged spaces allocated to Delegations in the villages.

7.3 PILLOWS/BEDDING/TOWELS

Delegation members are advised to bring their own towels and bedding (sheets, pillow, blankets) as these will not be supplied in the Athletes' Village. A futon mattress will be provided.

7.4 MEALS

The cafeteria will serve breakfast, lunch, and, dinner. Extended serving times are planned to permit most athletes to eat at the cafeteria without disturbing their competition schedule. A reusable water bottle will be provided to athletes on arrival in their Welcome Kits and water filling stations will be located in the village. These bottles are expected to be used by athletes at each meal, and for drinking water at sport venues.

Proper ID badge is required for entry into the cafeteria. Meals will be served in exchange for Meal Ticket/Voucher only.

Packed take-out meals will only be made available for teams whose competition schedule conflicts with the meal service schedule. These must be ordered 24 hours in advance for collection the following day. The request must be made at the morning Chefs de Mission Meeting the day before. Packed meals will not be delivered. It is the responsibility of the Chef de Mission to arrange for the collection and distributions of packed meals to their athletes. Packed meals will be exchanged for Meal Ticket/Voucher. Food



Services Workers will be stationed at cafeteria entrances.

7.5 INFECTION CONTROL AND ISOLATION

Games participants are advised to practice good health and infection control measures regarding food safety and minimizing the spread of diseases, through proper cough and hand washing etiquette. Dispose of waste in provided bins for recycling and composting.

7.6 WATER

Water dispensers will be provided in designated areas at the Athletes' Village.

7.7 HOUSEKEEPING

Residents of the Athletes' Village are responsible for maintaining cleanliness in the rooms. Brooms, trash bins, and bags will be provided. Residents are responsible to empty their trash bins in designated dumpsters daily.

7.8 VILLAGE AMENITIES

- Free Wi-Fi hotspots will be posted and available at village and certain venues
- Special 4G LTE service packages will be available for purchase
- NTA kiosk in village to provide all communication services and products (cell phones, MiFi)
- Recreational Area
